Sip & Frost Cake Bar's first Future Bakers Teen Summer Camp takes place at our Stonecrest location during June and July of 2024. Join us for a fun-filled summer of baking and learning! Whether you're a beginner or have some experience, our camp is designed to help you improve your skills and enjoy the art of baking. We look forward to seeing you at the Sip and Frost Cake Bar Future Bakers Teen Summer Camp!

Here are the main details you need to know for this year's Summer Camp:

Location: Sip & Frost Cake Bar • 8120 Mall Parkway #440 • Stonecrest, GA
Age Group: Teens (Boys and Girls Ages 13-17 years old)
Duration and Time Frame: 4 days, 5 hours (Monday-Thursday 10AM-3PM)
Dates (Choose a Session): Session 1: June 24-27

Session 2: July 8 -11 Session 3: July 15-18 Session 4: July 22-25

Class Size: Maximum of 4 students per session \*\*\*Space is LIMITED\*\*\*

#### What to Bring:

- 1. Each student must bring a hand mixer on the first day. All other tools are provided.
- 2. Each student must pack a lunch. Meals will not be served.

#### Cost: \$250.00 per student

#### **Additional Information:**

- All ingredients are provided during the camp.
- Students will receive recipes/instructions every step of the way.
- A Certificate of Completion will be awarded to each student on the final day of camp.



# Daily Overview

After Future Bakers Teen Summer Camp, students will know how to bake and decorate a cake, bake cookies from scratch, and how to sell their product. Most importantly, they'll know if baking is something they want to pursue as a career. Each day we will focus on an integral part of the baking process.

### Future Bakers is about much more than just baking!

Our daily activities are as follows:

## DAY 1: Shopping Experience

#### Morning

- Introduction to Sip and Frost Cake Bar
- Overview of the daily schedule and expectations
- Ice-breakers and team building exercises

#### Afternoon

- Trip to a local grocery store or specialty baking supply shop
- Guidance on selecting quality ingredients for baking
- Understanding ingredient labels and their importance in baking

## Day 2: Cookie Baking

#### Morning

- Introduction to basic cookie dough recipes
- Hands-on demonstration of cookie making techniques
- Tips for achieving different cookie textures (crispy, chewy, soft)

#### Afternoon

- Students bake their own batches of cookies under supervision
- Decorating techniques using icing and sprinkles
- Packaging and presenting cookies



## Day 3: Cake Baking and Decorating

#### Morning

- Basics of cake baking: different types of cakes and their uses
- Step-by-step guide to baking a simple cake from scratch
- Introduction to buttercream frosting: recipes and techniques

#### Afternoon

- Students bake their own cakes and prepare buttercream frosting
- Cake decorating techniques: piping, smoothing, and basic decorations
- Individualized guidance and troubleshooting

## Day 4: How to Effectively Start a Home Bakery Business

#### Morning

- Overview of starting a home bakery: legal considerations and permits
- Business planning essentials: pricing, marketing, and branding
- Customer service tips and handling orders

#### Afternoon

- Q&A session with owner/baker Lisa Jefferson, Sip and Frost Cake Bar
- Certificate of Completion ceremony
- Feedback and wrap-up



# Rules, Regulations, and Expectations for Students

- 1. *Respectful Behavior:* Students must treat instructors, staff, and fellow students with respect and courtesy at all times. No use of profanity is allowed during camp sessions. Vaping and smoking are also prohibited at all times.
- 2. *Attendance:* Students are expected to arrive on time. If students are unable to attend one or two days, advance notice must be given to the camp organizer. No refunds or cancellations will be given for missed days. **Students will not be allowed to leave the premises during camp hours without the permission of parent or guardian.**
- 3. *Safety First:* Students must follow all safety guidelines and instructions provided by instructors during all activities, especially baking activities. Students must handle equipment and tools with care to avoid accidents.
- 4. Use of Equipment: Students will only be allowed to use baking equipment and supplies under the supervision and guidance of instructors. Students must ask for help if unsure about operating any equipment.
- 5. *Hygiene:* Students must maintain personal hygiene standards for working in a bakery, including wearing closed-toe shoes, keeping long hair tied back, washing hands before handling ingredients or equipment, and wearing gloves when necessary.
- 6. *Cleanliness:* Students must keep workstations and common areas clean and tidy and dispose of waste properly.
- 7. Allergies and Dietary Restrictions: Students must inform instructors of any allergies or dietary restrictions prior to Day 1. Students must respect others' food allergies by avoiding cross-contamination and allergen exposure.
- 8. *Property Respect:* Respect the property of Sip and Frost Cake Bar, including equipment, tools, and facilities. Any damage caused due to negligence will be the responsibility of the student's parent or guardian.
- 9. *Cooperation:* Students are encouraged to participate actively in all activities and discussions and support and encourage fellow students each day.
- 10. *Cell Phone Policy:* Cell phones should be kept on silent mode during sessions. Use of cell phones for non-camp-related activities should be limited to designated break times.



- 11. *Compliance:* Follow all rules and regulations outlined in the waiver and any additional instructions provided by camp organizers. Failure to do so will result in immediate dismissal that will require the parent or guardian to pick up the student immediately after parent/guardian is notified.
- 12. *Prompt Pick-Up:* Students must be picked up promptly at the end of each session. If the student plans to be picked up by someone other than parent or guardian, **the name of that person must be texted to Lisa Jefferson** at 678.480.5054 prior to pick up. The text from parent or guardian's *phone number on file* should read as follows:

Ms. Lisa, I am aware [Student's Name] will be picked up by [Person's Name and Relationship to Child] today. His/Her phone number is [###-#####]. Thank you, [ Parent Or Guardian's Name].

- 13. *Parent/Guardian Communication:* All students must have a parent or guardian available in case of emergency during camp hours.
- 14. *What to Bring:* Students are required to bring a hand mixer on Day 1 and are encouraged to pack a light lunch each day. Students who don't have a hand mixer won't be able to participate.
